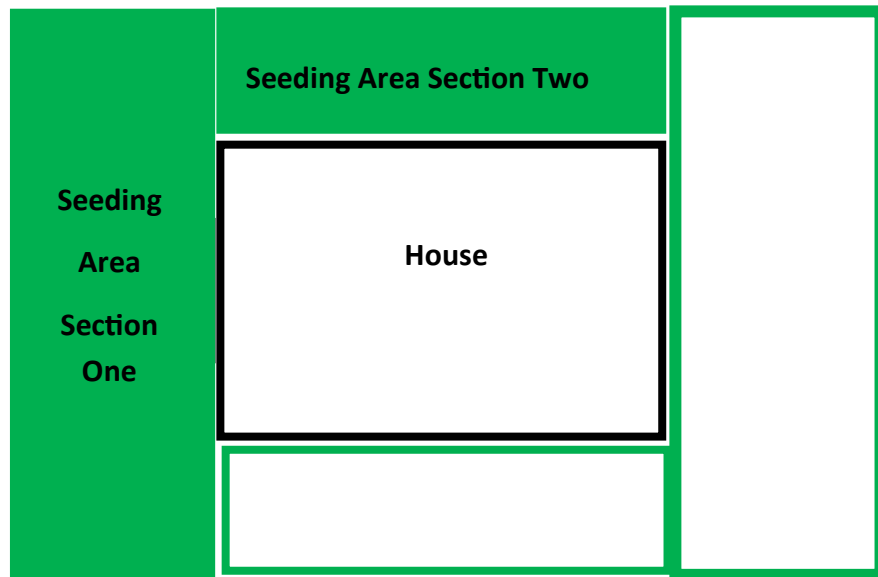


Your Seeding Calculator

If you are planning to seed your lawn yourself, you need to know how much seed to buy. We have designed this calculator to help! To use this calculator, simply decide how much of your lawn you will be seeding this year, calculate it's square footage, and plug the numbers into the equation below.

Example:



Step One: Multiply the Length and Width of each section and add them together.

Step Two: Use the equation (Square feet/1000) x 8 = Seed needed for your lawn!

Fescue seeding rates for seeding bare ground is 8 pounds per 1000 square feet. Seeding rate for over-seeding existing turf is 6 pounds per 1000 square feet.
